REMOTE NORTH AUSTRALIAN BNH CONTEXT 1

360,000 People

- + Communities from 'outer regional' to 'very remote'.
- + Remote communities mostly inhabited by indigenous Australians (% rises with remoteness)
- + Low population densities
- + Poor infrastructure
- + Poor communications
- + Disconnect with emergency management paradigm
- + Low levels of formal education and training
- + Limited labour market experience

REMOTE NORTH AUSTRALIAN BNH CONTEXT 2

Centre for Appropriate Technology

“A Failed State”

- = Almost no formal emergency management capacity
- = No spare capacity to fall back on
- = No “Plan B”
- = Very limited community resilience (?)






